

CHIPPEWA COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER OWNER RELEASE STATEMENT

The Chippewa County Animal Control Shelter is an open admission shelter. We take in all animals regardless of age, temperament, breed, health, behavior or aggressiveness. Hundreds of animals are received at this shelter annually. Because of our open admission policy, space is not always available and some animals are humanely euthanized. We will take your pet, however, we hope that you have explored all avenues of finding your pet a home prior to bringing it to us. Please carefully review the following statements so you are fully aware of the Shelter's philosophies and policies prior to surrendering your pet. If you are not willing to leave your pet under these terms, it will not be admitted to the shelter.

- 1. Be advised that you are giving up all legal rights to this animal(s).
- 2. We do not guarantee that your pet will be placed into the adoption program or will find a home if it is adopted.
- 3. The decision on whether to put the pet into the adoption program or humanely put to sleep (euthanize), may be made upon arrival. This decision is based on breed, temperament, health, age, history and room available.
- We will not call you to tell you if the animal is going to be euthanized. Information will not be released to you as to whether the animal is euthanized or adopted. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.
- 6. If you change your mind and want this pet back, if it is available, you will have to go through our adoption screening process and pay any associated fee(s).
- 7. All items brought in with the pet(s) are considered a donation and may be used for Shelter purposes. We do not guarantee that they will go with the pet, nor will they be returned to you once donated.

I have read and understand the above policy. I certify that I am the owner of this animal, free and clear of all other interests. I certify that the information I have provided about this animal is true and complete, and I have not willfully concealed information about the animal. I hereby forever release, discharge and agree to hold harmless and indemnify Chippewa County, its employees and agents from all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, or liability of any kind whatsoever arising as a result of or in connection with the adoption or other disposition of the animal described below.
